Section 3.2.2 'Financial and Economic capacity criteria' of the Tender Specifications shall be modified as follows:

F1	<p><i><u>(applicable to tenderer – in case of consortium – to each consortium member, and subcontractor used to meet criterion F2 individually)</u></i></p> <p>Tenderers must be in a stable financial position and have the economic and financial capacity to perform the contract.</p>	Submitting a full copy of the tenderer's annual accounts (balance sheet, profit and loss account, notes on the accounts and auditors' remarks when applicable) and financial statement in the form provided in Annex I.6 .
F2	<p><i><u>(applicable to tenderer – in case of consortium – all members of consortium, and subcontractors used to meet the criterion cumulatively)</u></i></p> <p>Tenderers shall prove minimum general turnover of EUR 1.000.000 (one million Euro) per year of which a minimum of EUR 500.000 (five hundred thousand Euro) per year shall be in high accuracy and/or GNSS positioning (specific turn-over).</p>	Submitting a statement of overall turnover and turnover relating to the relevant services of the last three years , as approved by the competent body of the company and, where applicable, audited and/or published (with reference to Annex I.6).

In order to meet the requirement of criterion F2, the tenderers may rely on subcontracting. When subcontracting is used in order for the tender to meet the minimum required financial and economic capacity level, subcontractors shall provide evidence that they fulfil F1 and F2 criteria, as per Annex I.6 of the Tender Specifications. In case subcontractors' economic and financial capacity is not relevant to the purpose of demonstrating compliance to the economic and financial capacity requirements, subcontractors are not requested to provide such evidence.

If, for some exceptional reason which GSA considers justified, a tenderer is unable to provide one or other of the above documents, the tenderer may prove its economic and financial capacity by any

other document which GSA considers appropriate. In any case, GSA must at least be notified of the exceptional reason and its justification in the tender. GSA reserves the right to request any other document enabling it to verify the tenderer's economic and financial capacity.
